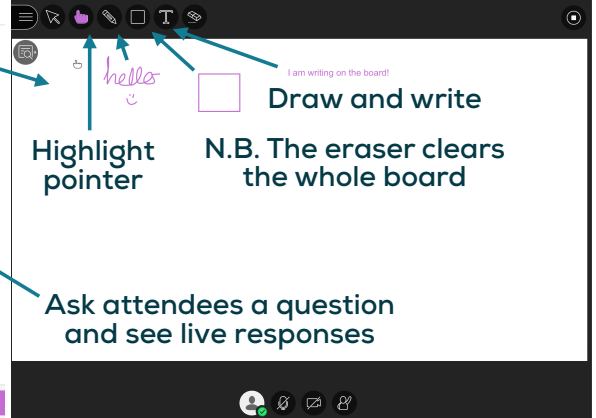
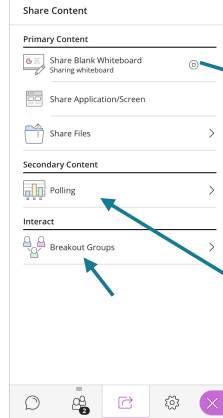
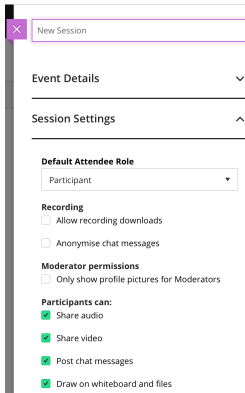
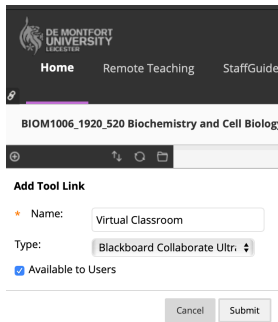
Create a virtual classroom

## 2 Making MCQs Ungoogleable

Dr Beth Rogoyski's top 5 tips for writing questions that google can't answer

Formulate

Let students formulate the question  
Ask the Q. without asking the Q.

Unanswerable

Encourage student intuition

Information

Ask the shortest question  
Don't give exact information

Multimedia

Use multimedia (carefully)  
Ask for interpretation  
Mix formats

Apply

Move up the pyramid!

Plan

Have a lesson plan and stick to time

Logical

Don't over-complicate it
